escorted to the mall security office. An unknown subject in the crowd yelled, "he's a state representative," several times. The subject was later identified as Daniel Foley. I then realized that Mr. Foley's chewing tobacco had been spit on my white duty polo shirt. Mr. Foley also possessed chewing tobacco on the front of his shirt.

The juveniles involved in the altercation were identified as [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. The juvenile's parents advised that they had resolved the situation. Both juveniles were advised of criminal trespass at the Roswell Mall, which is procedure for all subjects involved in a fight on mall property. The juveniles' parents were advised that they could take their children home. Mr. Schooley's father began to laugh and ridicule our actions.

Mr. Foley was taken out of handcuffs and allowed to make telephone calls in the mall security office. Officers then finished their investigation. Mr. Foley was advised that he was under arrest and placed in handcuffs. Mr. Foley was then transported to the Roswell Police Department. Mr. Foley was read the Miranda Warnings. Mr. Foley was allowed to make telephone calls. Mr. Foley contacted several persons including his attorney. Mr. Foley was fingerprinted and photographed. Officer Hernandez then served Mr. Foley with a criminal complaint. Mr. Foley's attorney then arrived at the Police Department. Mr. Foley released his property to his attorney, which included \$9.25, two cellular telephones, a chrome wedding band, a bottle of cough spray, deodorant, a black bag, car keys and several note pad pages. Mr. Foley was transported to the Chaves County Detention Center.

DISPOSITION

Mr. Foley was transported to the Chaves County Detention Center where he was incarcerated in lieu of posting a \$900.00 SURETY BOND.
